ANNEX II : ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

- 1 The toy was accompanied by detailed assembly instructions. However, these instructions must clearly state that adult assembly is required or that the proper assembly is checked by an adult before use.
- 2 Although the space between the rear wheel and the surrounding body is between 5mm and 12mm, it is highly unlikely that a child will be able to insert a finger in this part of the toy, whilst the scooter is being ridden. Annex A .20 (First paragraph, second sentence) states that " The requirements are intended to address the hazards associated with wheel arrangements capable of crushing fingers and other parts of the body, if entrapped. It was considered that the position in question (rear wheel and surrounding body) was unlikely to crush a child's finger. This rationale is supported by PD CEN/ TR 15371:2006, clause 2.4.
- 3 A modified sample submitted on 29/10/2008 was tested to EN 71-1 clause 4.15.5.6. The other results are taken from the original report (originally tested and reported under ALC K113111:0908).
- 4 Regulation 10 of The Toys (Safety) Regulations 1995 - marking requirements:

CE marking : required

CE mark: present. Height: 6 mm (5mm minimum).

(Note: CE marking should be in accordance with EC Directive 93/68/EEC).

Company name and an address within the EU required? : YES.

Company name and an address within the EU present? : YES.

Note to retain information required? : YES.

Note to retain information present? : YES.
- 5 The sample was not manifestly unsuitable for children under 36 months but was not considered to be intended for children under 36 months.

Due to potential hazards identified during testing the following warning is required on the toy or retail packaging: "Not suitable for children under 36 months due to small parts."

Note: The word "Warning" may precede the text. The warning must be clearly legible at the point of sale.

- 6 The packaging ,if there is any, and the instructions for use, shall carry the following warning:

"Warning. Protective equipment should be worn.

Not for children with a body weight of more than 20kg".

- 7 Other components from the sample due to their function, mass, size or other characteristics, exclude any hazard due to sucking, licking and swallowing, bearing in mind the normal and foreseeable behaviour of children, and are not subject to the migration requirements of the standard

- 8 Date of test: 6/10/08

In cases where the mass of test portion was between 10 mg and 100 mg the mass is stated. In such instances, the results were calculated assuming that 100mg of sample had been obtained.

An ICP optical emission spectrometer was used for the analyses. For results refer to Annex III.

It was assumed that components of a similar type and colour were of identical chemical composition.

Description of test portion and additional information (where applicable):

- 1 Laminated paper decals
- 2 Clear plastic "Micro" decal
- 3 Red plastic decal (35mg)
- 4 Soft black plastic handle grips
